Kern County (Delano/McFarland): **OFM** – F2 Biofix (third flight) 6/14, 540DD. **PTB** - F1 Biofix 6/1, 702DD. **CRS** – 2nd flight Biofix 6/15, 425DD. **SJS** – Second Male flight (F1) Biofix 5/28, 783DD. **OLR** – F1 (second flight) Biofix 5/24, 969DD. **NOW** – Second flight Biofix 6/21, 216DD. Almond hull split occurred last week in most locations.

Tulare County (NE Kingsburg area): **CM** – Visalia Walnuts – F1 Biofix 6/3, 664DD. Kingsburg plums – F1 Biofix 6/13 (adjusted from previous report), 464DD. **OFM** – F2 Biofix 6/20, 373DD. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/8, 561DD. **CRS** – F1 (second flight) biofix 6/10, 495DD. Expect increased crawler activity in a few days. **OLR** – F1 Biofix 5/30, 830DD. **SJS** – F1 Biofix 5/28, 774DD.

Madera County: **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/7, 525DD. **OFM** - F2 Biofix 6/18, 340DD. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/1, 649DD. **OLR** – F1 Biofix 5/22, 950DD. **NOW** – Second flight Biofix 6/24, 141DD.

Merced County (Ballico & Winton areas): **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/9 (adjusted from previous report), 434DD. **OFM** - F2 Biofix 6/16, 397DD. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/16 (adjusted from previous report), 322DD.

Butte County (Gridley): **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/13, 309DD. **OFM** – F2 Biofix 6/24, 216DD. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/22, 450DD.
