**Kern County** (Delano/McFarland: **CM** – Biofix 4/5, 988DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/20, 572DD. **PTB** – Biofix 4/1, 1021D. **CRS** – Biofix 3/24, 910DD. Deploy traps for 2<sup>nd</sup> flight now. **SJS** – Biofix 3/18, 1100DD. New flight activity has just started. **OLR** – Biofix 6/7, 210DD. **NOW** – Biofix 4/28, 590DD.

**Tulare County** (NE Kingsburg area except where noted): **CM** (Visalia walnuts) – Biofix 4/12, 970DD. Expect next flight to begin 6/20-21. **CM** – Kingsburg Biofix 4/12, 973DD. **OFM** – Biofix 4/30, 533DD. Hatch happening now. **PTB** – Biofix 4/16, 949DD. **CRS** (Visalia/Exeter) – Biofix 3/30, 847DD. Expect next flight to start 6/28-29.

**Madera County:** **CM** – Biofix 4/20, 792DD. **OFM** - F1 Biofix 6/4, 285DD. **PTB** – Biofix 4/15, 841DD. Shoot strikes with late instar larvae. **CRS** – Biofix 4/15, 705DD. Sprays being applied for emerging crawlers. **SJS** – Biofix 4/6, 860DD. **OLR** – Biofix 6/15, 20DD. **NOW**- Biofix 4/15, 620DD. Late instars in egg traps.

**Merced County** (Ballico & Winton areas): **CM** – Biofix 4/9, 882DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/28, 494DD. **PTB** – Biofix 4/15, 838DD.

**Sacramento County** (Delta area): **CM** – Biofix 4/9, 858DD.

**Yuba County** (Marysville): **CM** – Biofix 4/18, 930DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/24, 583DD.

**Butte County** (Gridley): **CM** – Biofix 4/2, 859DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 6/7, 226DD. **PTB** – Biofix 4/27, 892DD. **WHF** – UC guidelines are to deploy Walnut Husk Fly traps in this area in mid-June. WHF emergence is very site-specific rather than area-wide.

**NOTE: Be sure to put your Walnut Husk Fly traps in your orchards now.**
