Kern County (Delano/McFarland: **CM** – F1 (2nd flight) Biofix 6/21, 222DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/20, 1032DD. 3rd flight starting. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/17, 270D. **CRS** – Biofix 3/24, 1168DD. 2nd flight starting. **SJS** – F1 Biofix 6/14, 319DD. **OLR** – Biofix 6/7, 515DD. Key timing window in progress. **NOW** – Biofix 4/28, 819DD. Exceptionally slow development this season. **Misc.** – Lots of Grape Leaf Skeletonizer and False Chinch Bug in the southern SJV.

Tulare County (NE Kingsburg area except where noted): **CM** (Visalia walnuts) – F1 Biofix 6/20, 267DD. **CM** – (Kingsburg) F1 Biofix 6/24, 194DD. **OFM** – Biofix 4/30, 913DD. Expect F2 flight to begin this week. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/27, 118DD. **CRS** (Visalia/Exeter) – F1 Biofix 6/28, 88DD. Second flight traps should be in the groves.

Madera County: **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/28, 80DD. **OFM** - F1 Biofix 6/4, 750DD. Late instars found in shoots. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/24, 154DD. Small larvae found. **CRS** – Biofix 4/15, 1010DD. **SJS** – Biofix 6/24, 154DD. **OLR** – Biofix 6/15, 390DD. **NOW**- Biofix 4/15, 895DD.

Merced County (Ballico & Winton areas): **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/27, 108DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/28, 832DD. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/27, 85DD.

Sacramento County (Delta area): **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/26, 97DD.

Yuba County (Marysville): **CM** – F1 Biofix 4/18, 280DD. **OFM** – F2 Biofix 6/26, 113DD.

Butte County (Gridley): **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/26, 108DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 6/7, 226DD. **PTB** – Biofix 4/27, 991DD. Flights have been strong for past 3 weeks. **WHF** – UC guidelines are to deploy Walnut Husk Fly traps in this area in mid-June. WHF emergence is very site specific rather than area-wide.

NOTE: Be sure to put your Walnut Husk Fly traps in your orchards now.
