**NOTE: Oriental Fruit Moth (OFM)** – Moth catch is expected in all areas as soon as weather warms. Traps should be in place for that warm weather.

**Kern County** (Delano/McFarland): **OFM** – A few moths trapped 2/16 and 2/28. No biofix yet.

**Tulare County** (NE Kingsburg area): **OFM** – No activity

**Madera County**: **OFM** - No activity

**Merced County** (Ballico & Winton areas): **OFM** – No activity

**Sacramento County** (Delta area): **OFM** – No activity

**Yuba County** (Marysville): **OFM** – No activity

**Butte County** (Gridley): **OFM** – No activity

**MARCH:** CM, CM-DA COMBO, DA, CM 10X, CRS, DBM AND PTB traps should be set.
