Kern County (Delano/McFarland): **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/17, 140DD. Second flight spray timing approaching. **OFM** – F1 biofix 5/13, 927DD. F2 (third flight) emergence is imminent. **PTB** – Biofix 6/15, 215DD. **CRS** – Biofix 3/31, 1094DD. Key second flight beginning at this time. **SJS** – F1 Biofix 6/14, 230DD. **OLR** – F1 Biofix 6/9, 263DD. **NOW** – First egg laying in traps from overwintered generation 4/24, 766DD.

Tulare County (NE Kingsburg area except where noted): **CM** (Kingsburg plums) – F1 Biofix 6/20, 89DD. **CM** – (Tulare walnuts) F1 Biofix 6/17, 154DD. 2A treatments, if needed, about 6/27 in this area. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 6/4, 522DD. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/13, 138DD. **CRS** (Exeter) – Biofix 4/1, 974DD. Expect F2 flight 6/27-28. Traps should be in place in untreated citrus. **SJS** – Biofix 6/13, 260DD.

Madera County: **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/20, 52DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/30, 560DD. **PTB** – F1 Biofix 6/21, 30DD. Catching moths in almonds. **OLR** - F1 Biofix 6/10, 320DD. Heavy flight. **NOW** – Biofix (egg laying) 4/18, 760DD.

Merced County (Ballico & Winton areas): **CM** – Biofix 4/7, 915DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/25, 577DD. **PTB** – Biofix 4/15, 881DD.

Sacramento County (Delta area): **CM** – Biofix 4/15, 877DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 6/1, 484DD.

Yuba County (Marysville): **CM** – F1 Biofix 6/22, 29DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/26, 621DD.

Butte County (Gridley): **CM** – Biofix 4/18, 860DD. **OFM** – F1 Biofix 5/30, 527DD. **PTB** – Biofix 4/18, 860DD.
